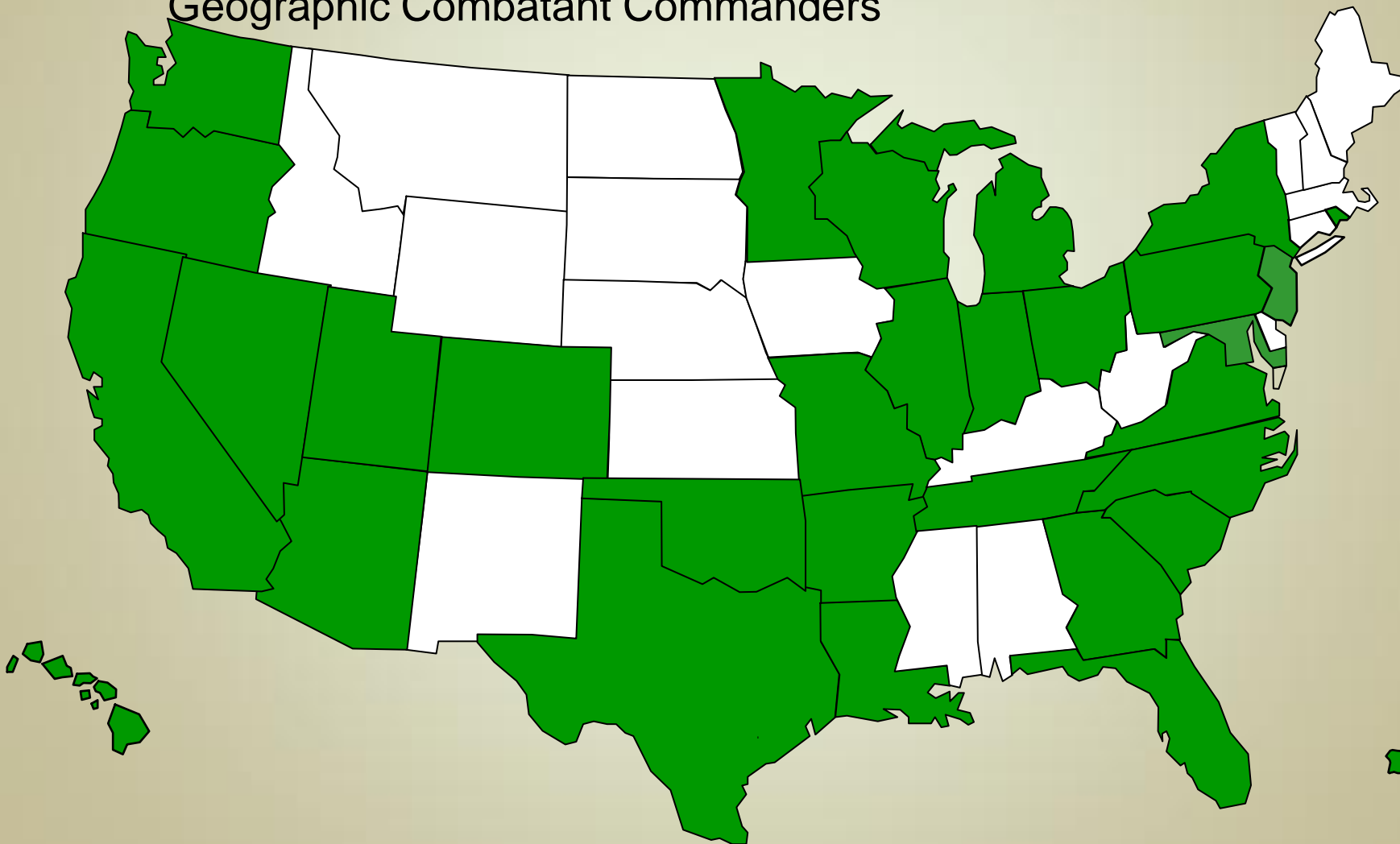


Mission

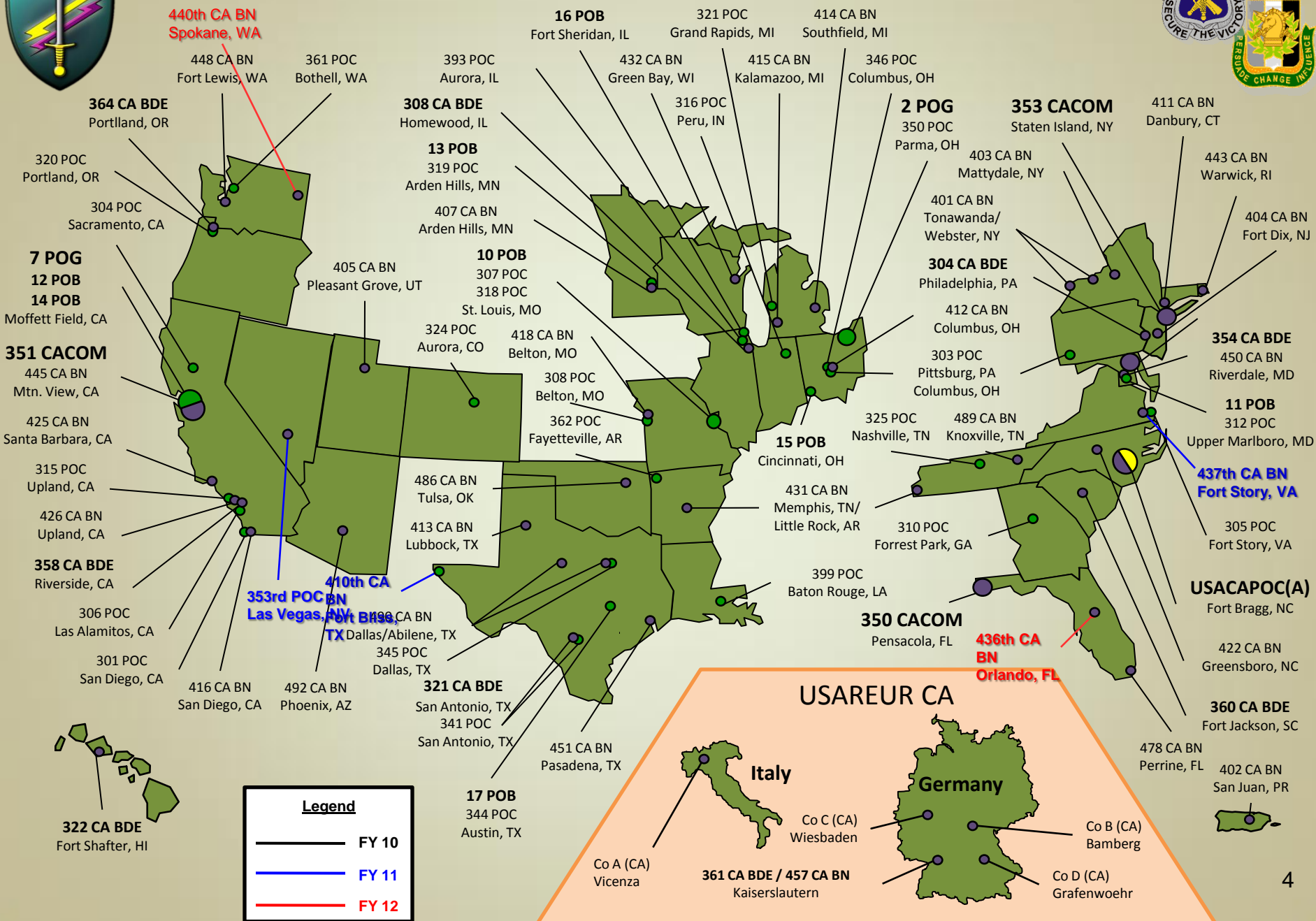

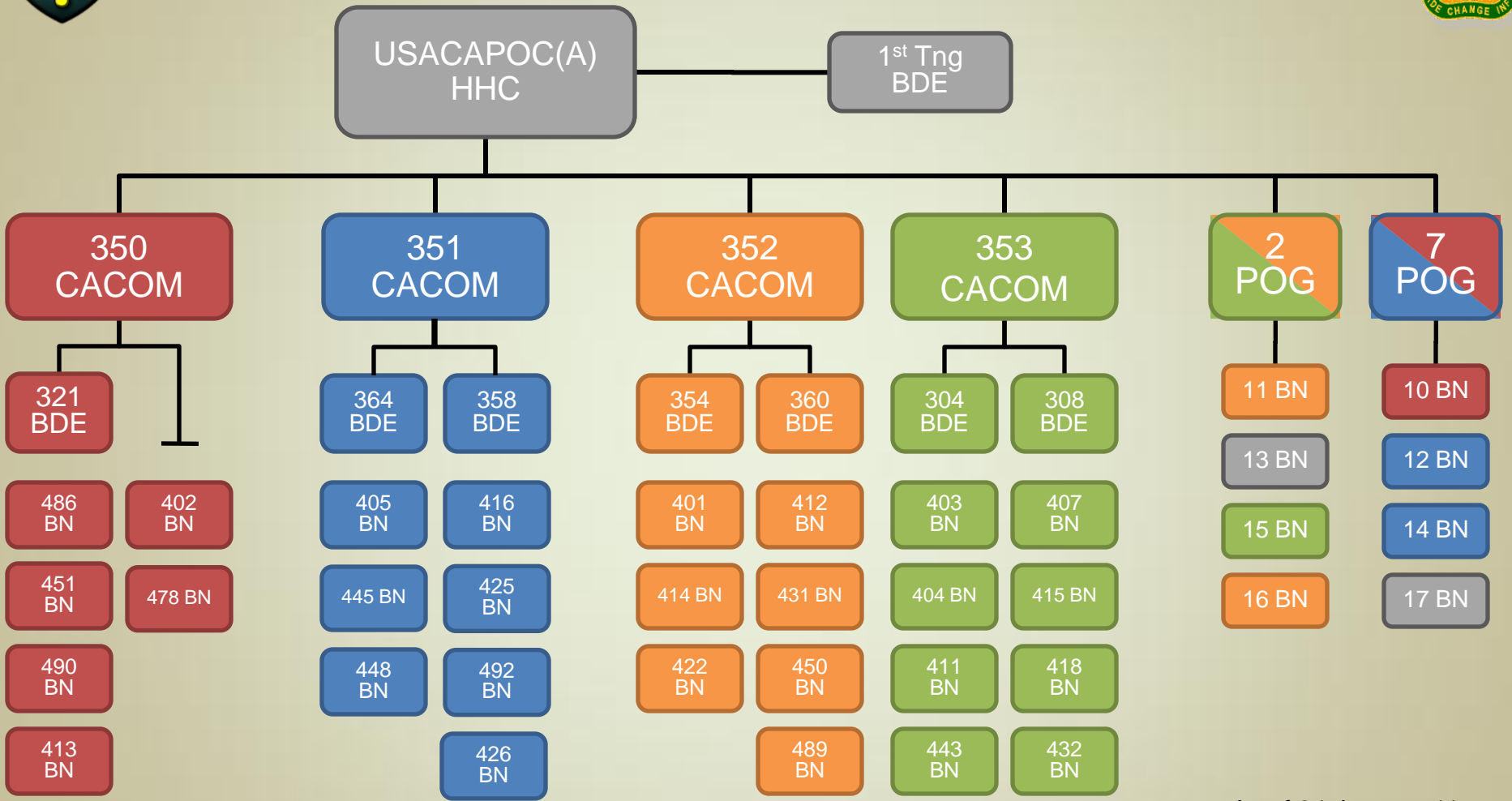


Location of USACAPOC(A) Units

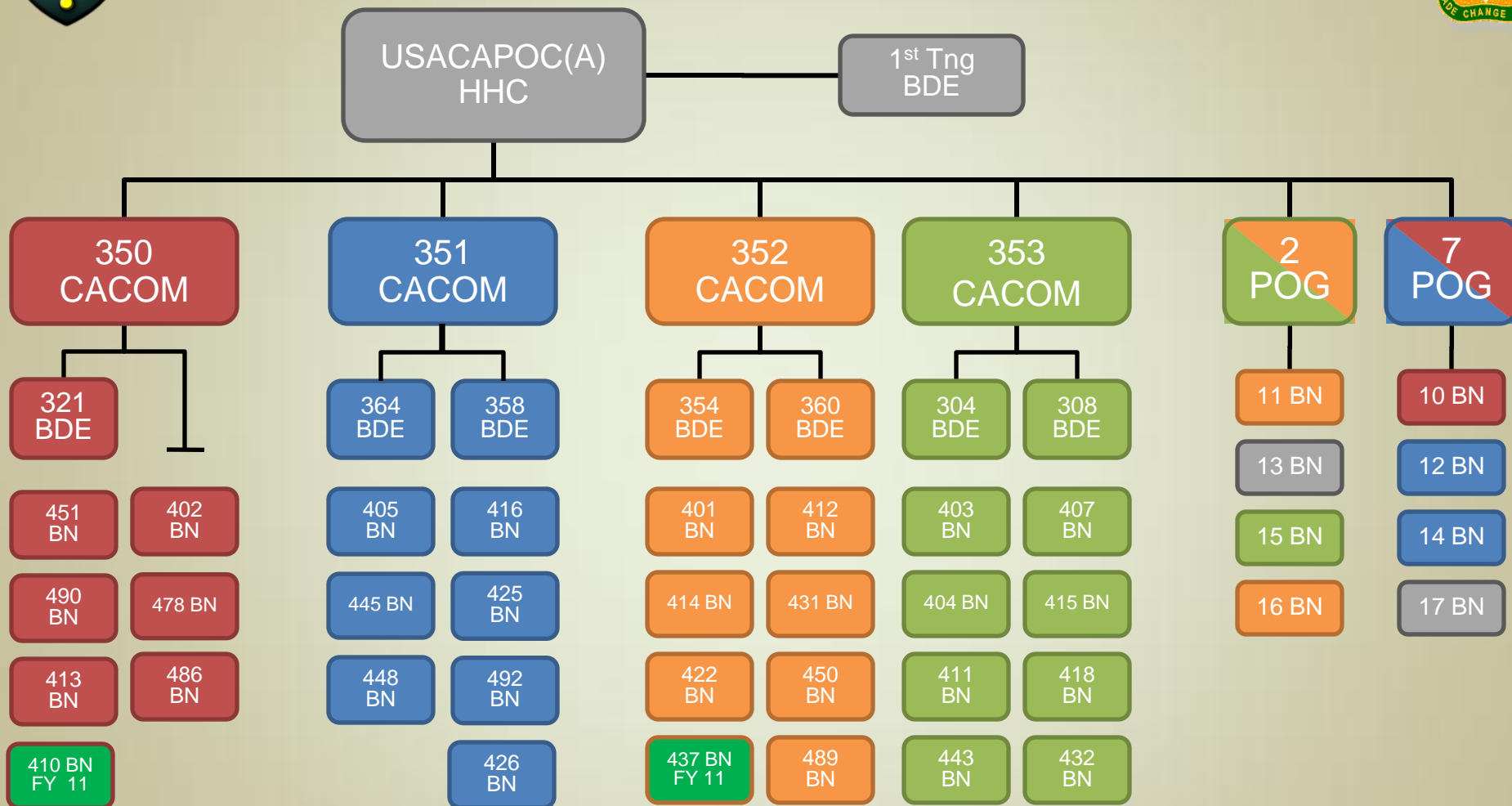

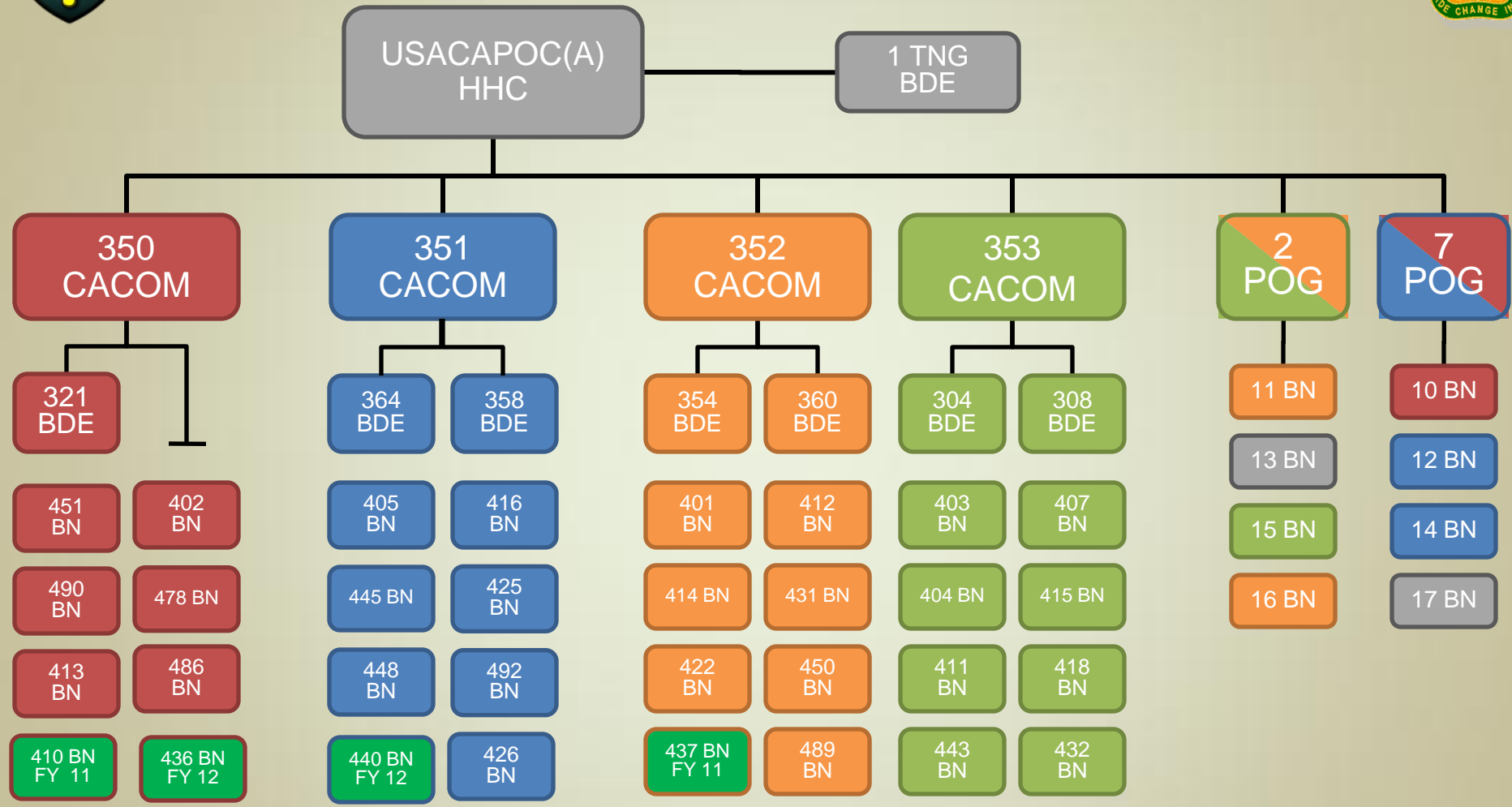


Future Organization FY11

PDM-III Approved CA Growth



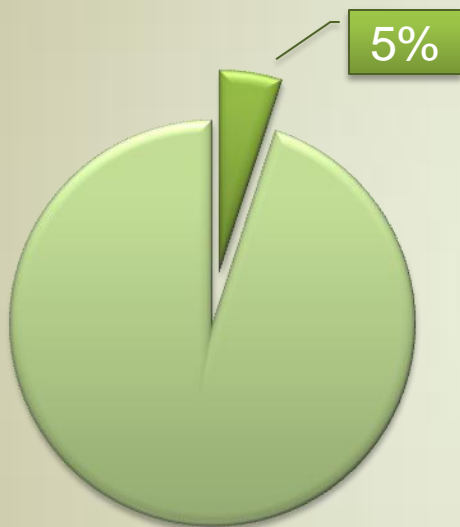
- Programmed Army Reserve CA structure growth is:
 - FY10: 1 CA BDE/1 BN/4 COs (Germany)
 - FY11: 2 BNs/4 COs each
 - FY12: 2 BNs/4 COs each
- Programmed Active Component (AC) growth is:
 - FY11: 1 CA BDE/1 BN/6 COs
 - FY12: 2 CA BNs/6 COs each
 - FY13: 2 CA BNs/6 COs each



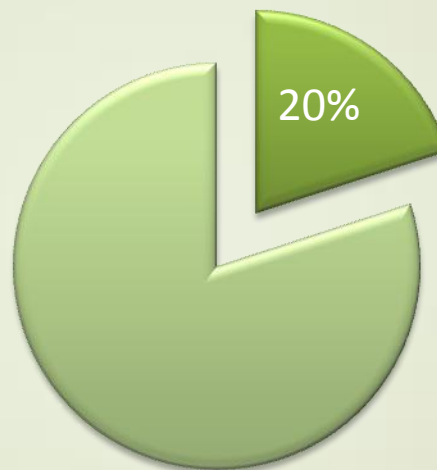
USACAPOC (A) Personnel Contribution to USARC OCO Deployment FY11

USARC GWOT deploys ~ 7,000+ per rotation (~every 10 months)

USACAPOC(A) deploys ~ 1,300+ per rotation (~every 10 months)
